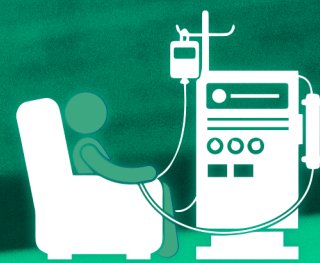

CHEMOTHERAPY AND BIOLOGICAL THERAPY PROJECT

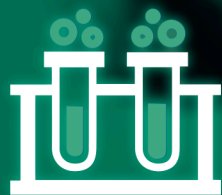
