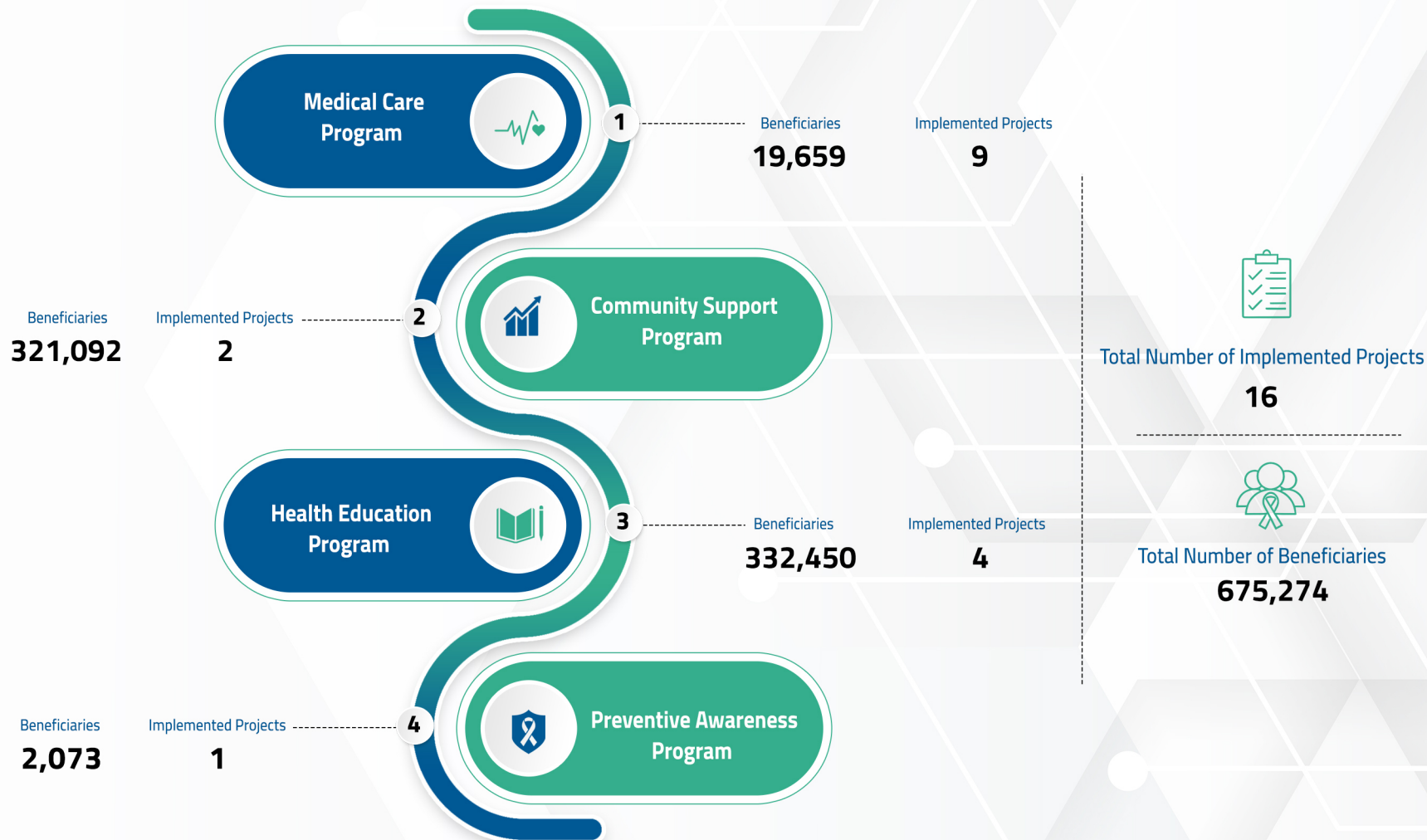

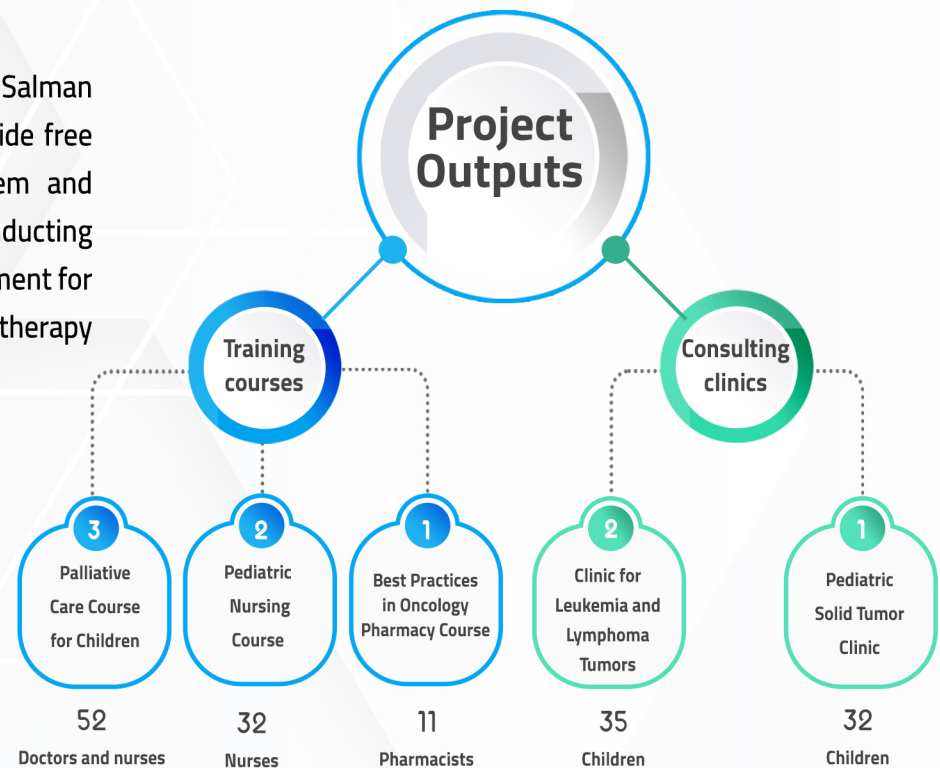


## Children's Tumour Camp Project

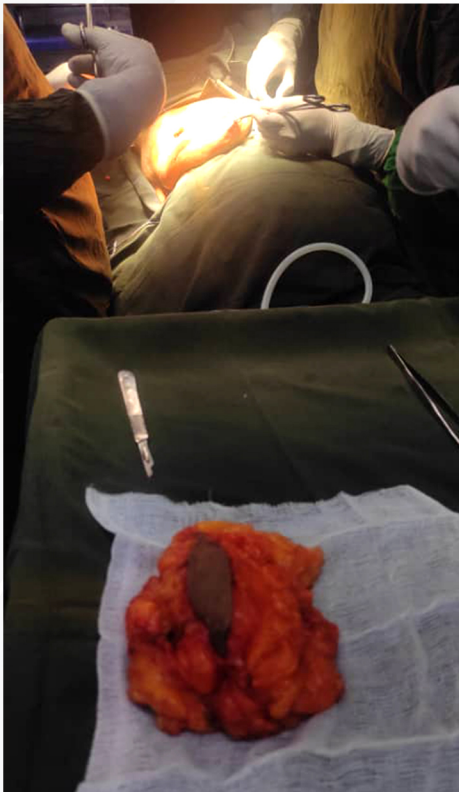

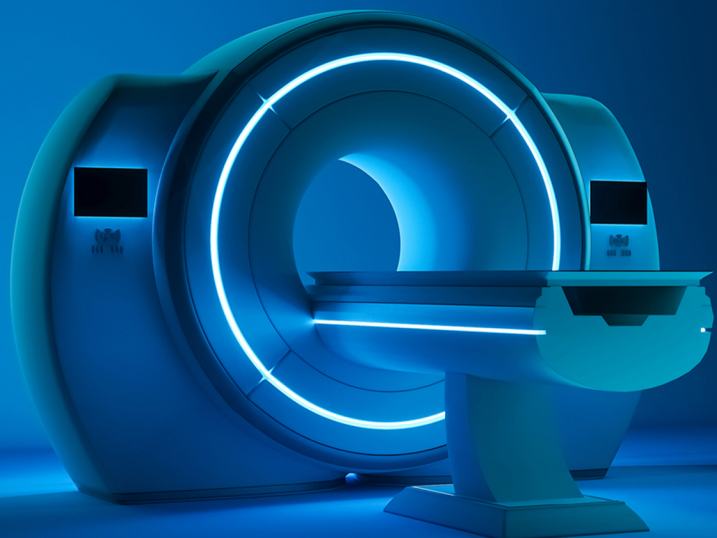

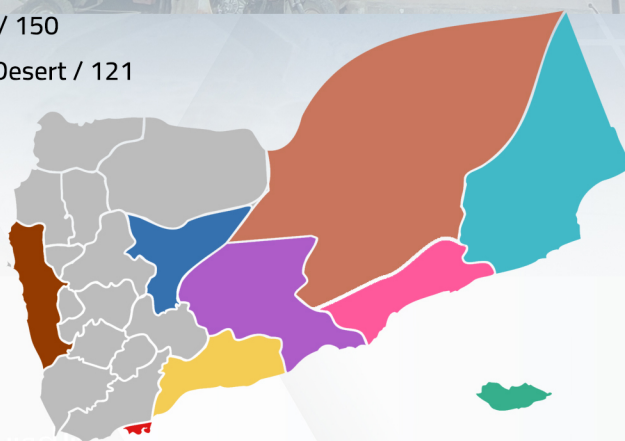


## Charity Housing Project

The Foundation established this project to ensure continuous treatment for cancer patients at the Mukalla Tumor Center. It provides charity housing for patients and their families—especially those traveling from outside the Hadramaut governorate or the Mukalla district—for a symbolic fee near the treatment facility. This effort is aimed at alleviating the high cost of accommodation and reducing the burden of travel by establishing treatment centers closer to their regions.

Some cancer patients in Hadramout Governorate suffer because their treatment is unavailable in local tumor centers. This is either due to the lack of some essential medical facilities and equipment or because their condition requires specialization that is not available among the medical staff.

Therefore, the Foundation extends help to these patients by providing the necessary financial assistance and covering their travel tickets abroad.

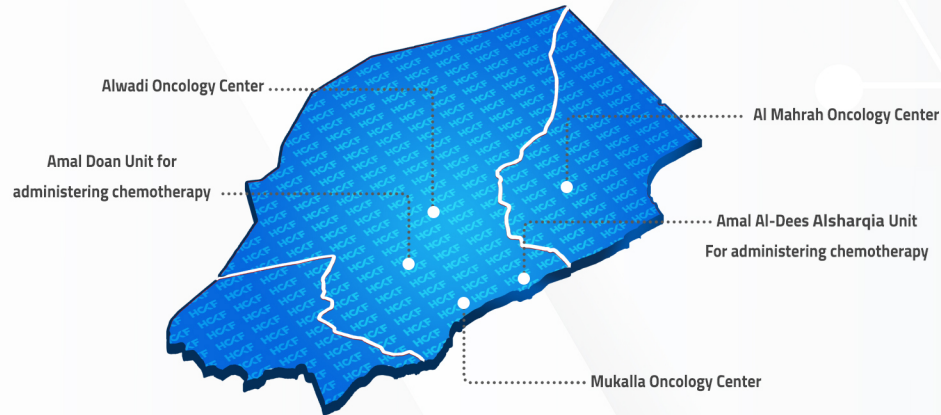

## Amal Units for Chemotherapy Treatment

The Amal Program was not merely a slogan for the Foundation; it materialized through the establishment of facilities to administer chemotherapy doses to cancer patients, relieving them of the hardship, difficulties, travel costs, accommodation, transportation, and treatment expenses. This began with the establishment of the Do'an Amal Unit at Al-Dahi Al-Do'ani Hospital on December 19, 2020. This is followed by the establishment phase of the Al-Dis Al-Sharqiya Amal Unit at the Public Hospital in Al-Dis Al-Sharqiya, and similarly, the establishment phase of the Al-Mahra Amal Unit at Al-Ghaydah Hospital in Al-Mahra Governorate.
