We established our main headquarters in the city of Mukalla as the first specialized foundation in the field of cancer control in the Hadhramaut region. We offer a series of programs and projects based on careful studies to meet community needs.

The Foundation works to care for cancer patients, providing them with medical, psychological, social, and financial support throughout all stages of treatment, in addition to a set of awareness projects aimed at reducing the spread of cancer and promoting its early detection. We are further distinguished by operating under an administrative and financial system built on accredited international standards, holding the ISO 9001:2015 international quality certificate, and being a member of the Gulf Federation for Cancer Control.

Our institutional identity project continued, with its name resonating with our national and humanitarian goals. This year, we achieved a qualitative leap in the level of our services across Hadhramaut and Southern Yemen, as the Foundation is the sole umbrella providing care services to cancer patients in the southern and eastern governorates, while also serving as a consultation reference.

We successfully completed the Nutrition and Supportive Therapy Project, benefiting over 1,500 patients, and launched the Rehabilitative Care Project, which serves thousands of patients annually. We also launched the Accurate Diagnostic Project (PET scan), the first of its kind in Yemen, aiming to raise the quality of patient diagnosis.

In our persistent pursuit of comprehensive and integrated treatment, we expanded our scope of support to encompass the curative, humanitarian, social, psychological, and financial aspects for patients.

What fuels our pride and commitment is that cancer patients who receive our free services tell me they see hope in the Foundation.

I extend my sincere thanks and gratitude to our loyal partners, whose continuous support and charitable initiatives have helped the Foundation sustain its work and increase its impact.


We reaffirm our renewed commitment to our noble mission and are working steadily toward a bright future for cancer patients and the control of this disease.


1 Amal Units for Chemotherapy (hope Units)

In collaboration with government agencies, the private sector, and civil society organizations, the Hadhramaut Foundation launched the "Hope Units" program. This program aims to provide healthcare for cancer patients by establishing specialized chemotherapy units in underserved areas. Through these partnerships, the Foundation seeks to create a supportive and healthy environment for cancer patients.

Following the success of the "Amal Doan Unit" project in 2020, the Foundation aims, through this program, to facilitate patients' access to necessary treatment and bring healthcare services closer to them in numerous areas, both within and outside Hadhramaut. This will contribute to improving their chances of recovery and alleviating their suffering and that of their families.

The 'Amal Al-Mahrah Unit' represents a qualitative addition to healthcare services for cancer patients in Al-Mahrah Governorate. It was established to meet the increasing demand for chemotherapy in the region and to provide patients with the necessary healthcare. The unit is equipped with advanced medical technologies, and the medical and technical staff have been trained on the latest therapeutic protocols, making this unit an effective contributor to the fight against cancer throughout Al-Mahrah Governorate.





Chemotherapy, Biological, and Complementary Medications

The Foundation launched a comprehensive program to provide **chemotherapy, biological, and complementary medications free of charge to all registered patients at Hadhramaut Oncology Centers and units. This initiative addresses the urgent need for free medication, particularly given the high costs.



Complementary Therapy

All additional medications needed for cancer patients coming from all governorates and the Horn of Africa.

Biological Therapy

Advanced treatment targeting cancer cells precisely, reducing side effects.

Chemotherapy

Provides essential drugs for treating various tumor types, chosen according to tumor type, stage, and patient condition.

The Surgical Operations Project ensures that all cancer patients in need receive necessary surgical care, covering surgery costs through a wide network of hospitals and specialized surgeons. It facilitates procedures, reduces waiting times, and enables timely treatment. The project also promotes community awareness about the importance of surgery and improves the perception of medical professionals as partners in community health.






6 Laboratory Tests Program

To achieve an accurate diagnosis of cancer, since the establishment of the institution, we have been committed to supporting all laboratory tests, including sample tests, tumor markers, and tissue tests for patients. We have been able to alleviate their financial burden by providing financial support of up to (50%) of the value of any laboratory test they need. We are keen to ensure that this support is available to our patients throughout the stages of their treatment journey, from the initial diagnosis to the follow-up stage after treatment. This support is provided directly to the patient, making it easier for them to obtain the necessary results to start treatment or to see the doctor in a timely manner.










7 Medical Camps Project

Albumin is an essential component of supportive care for cancer patients; it is a crucial protein that helps alleviate the side effects of chemotherapy and radiotherapy. It also maintains blood volume and pressure, thereby enhancing the body's ability to fight the disease.

Meanwhile, nutritional supplements play a significant role in boosting immunity and providing the essential nutrients needed for recovery.

To alleviate the suffering of cancer patients and provide them with a comfortable environment during their treatment, our organization continues to provide free charitable housing, with the aim of providing comfortable and safe accommodation for patients and their companions coming from outside the city of Mukalla or Hadhramaut Governorate, thus saving them the trouble of traveling and staying in hotels and moving between the accommodation and the center, and ensuring their continuity in receiving treatment without interruption that leads to the exacerbation of the disease.








2 "Musanad" Support Project


