We take pride in operating under an administrative and financial system based on accredited international standards, holding the International Quality Certificate (ISO 9001:2015), in addition to our membership in the Gulf Federation for Cancer Control.



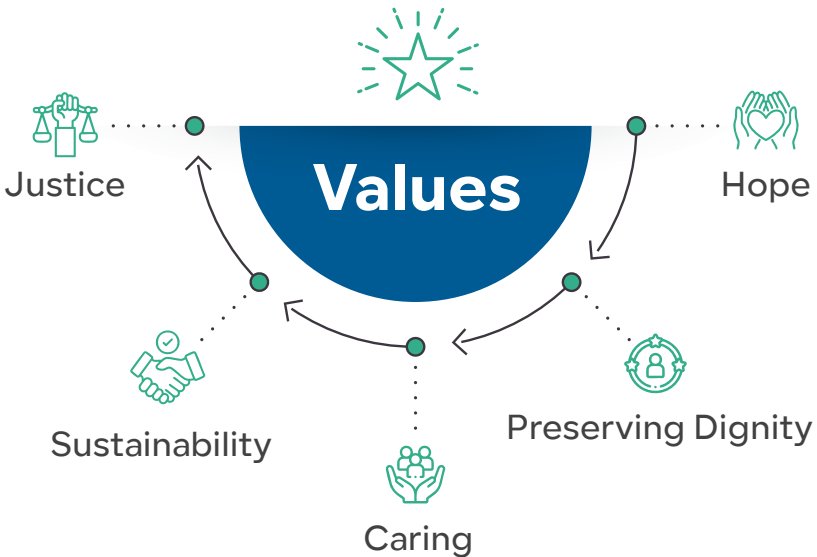

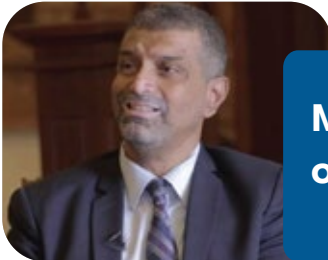




Message from the Chairman of the Board of Founders

It gives us great pleasure to present the 2025 Annual Report, which embodies another year in the journey of the Hadhramaut Cancer Control Foundation. Despite the health and economic challenges of the year, the Foundation continued its mission with the support of partners and donors, benefiting 7,636 individuals through various programs providing integrated therapeutic, diagnostic, and care services.

In 2025, our work centered on the Medical Care Program, which provided chemotherapy, biological, and complementary treatments, as well as radiotherapy and surgical operations. We also provided travel tickets for patients referred for treatment abroad and maintained the Charity Housing project to ease the burden on patients coming from remote areas.

Furthermore, the Prevention Promotion Program continued its vital work through specialized early detection clinics for breast cancer and a smoking cessation clinic. Within our Social Integration Program, the "Musamid" (Supportive) project launched several humanitarian initiatives, including school bag distributions for children, field visits for psychological support, and sacrificial meat distribution during Eid. The Health Education Program also remained active, promoting health awareness through breast cancer campaigns, tobacco and Qat control initiatives, and participation in the Gulf Cancer Awareness Week.

In closing, we extend our deepest gratitude to everyone who supported us—donors, medical and administrative staff, and volunteers. We especially thank our heroic patients and their families, whose patience and determination remain our constant source of inspiration.

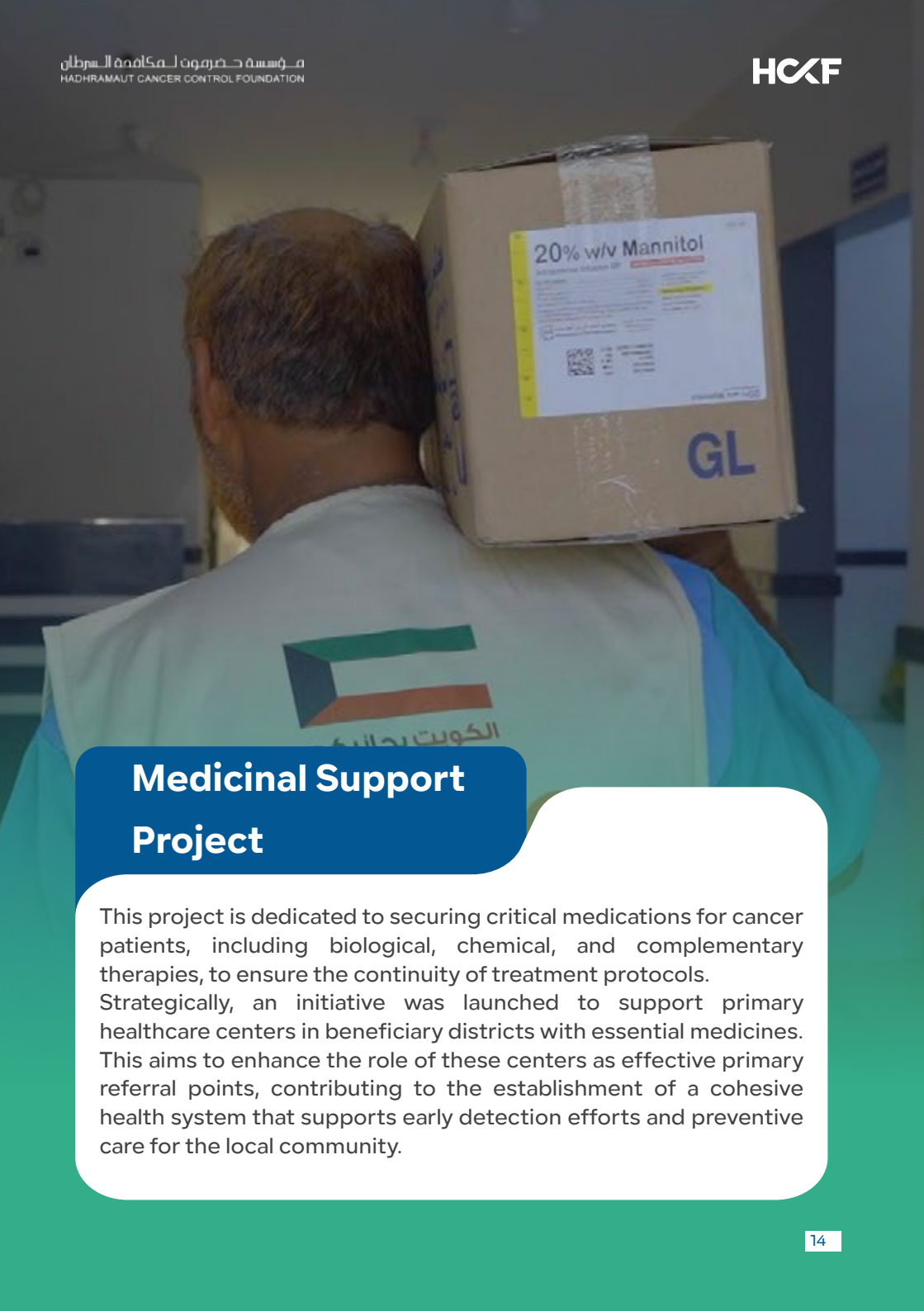

Medicinal Support Project

This project is dedicated to securing critical medications for cancer patients, including biological, chemical, and complementary therapies, to ensure the continuity of treatment protocols. Strategically, an initiative was launched to support primary healthcare centers in beneficiary districts with essential medicines. This aims to enhance the role of these centers as effective primary referral points, contributing to the establishment of a cohesive health system that supports early detection efforts and preventive care for the local community.



Specialized Therapeutic Medications

This project focuses directly on ensuring the continuity of treatment for cancer patients. It works to provide biological, chemical, and complementary high-cost medications. Providing these medicines means responding to the patient's most urgent needs, allowing them to continue their treatment plans without interruption, and focusing on the journey to recovery instead of worrying about costs.

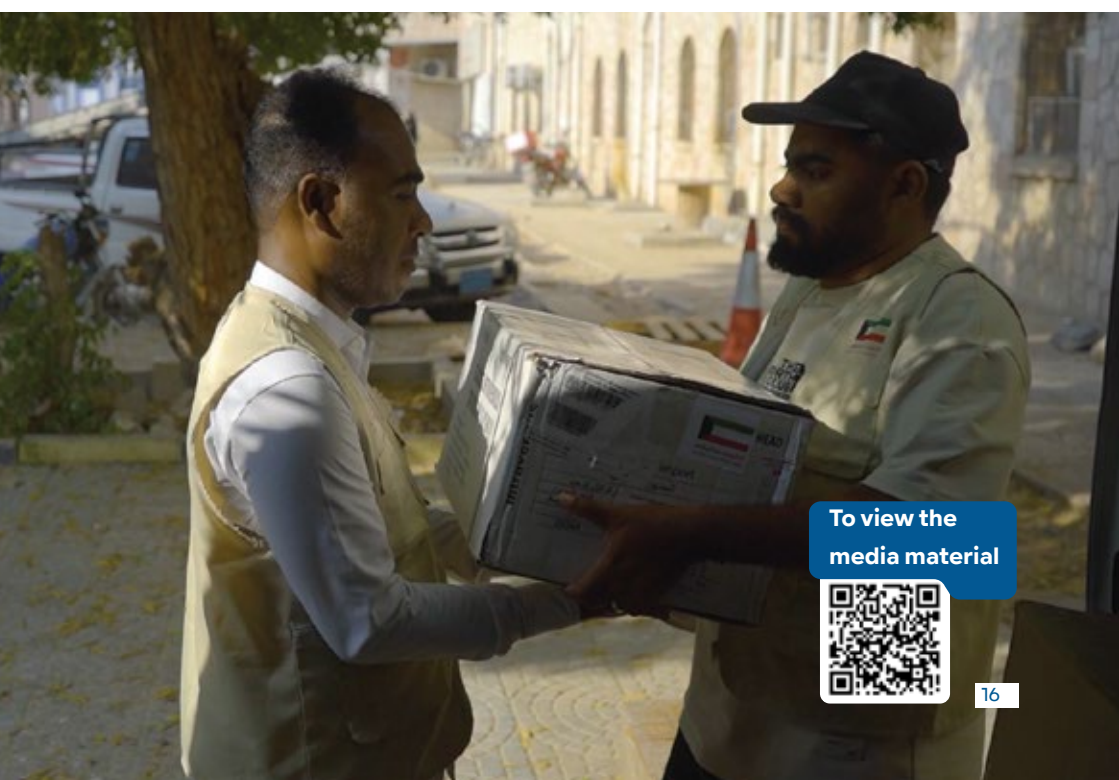

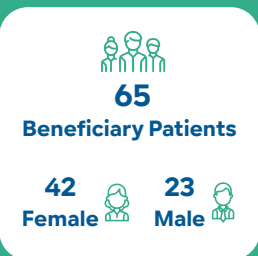

Diagnostic Radiology Project

This project aims to overcome the difficulties in accessing advanced medical imaging techniques, such as MRI, CT scans, X-rays, Ultrasound, and Mammograms. These are crucial tools for early cancer detection and accurately determining the extent of tumor spread. The project also includes providing complementary materials (such as contrast dyes) free of charge to ensure the quality of diagnostic images required for rapid and effective intervention.

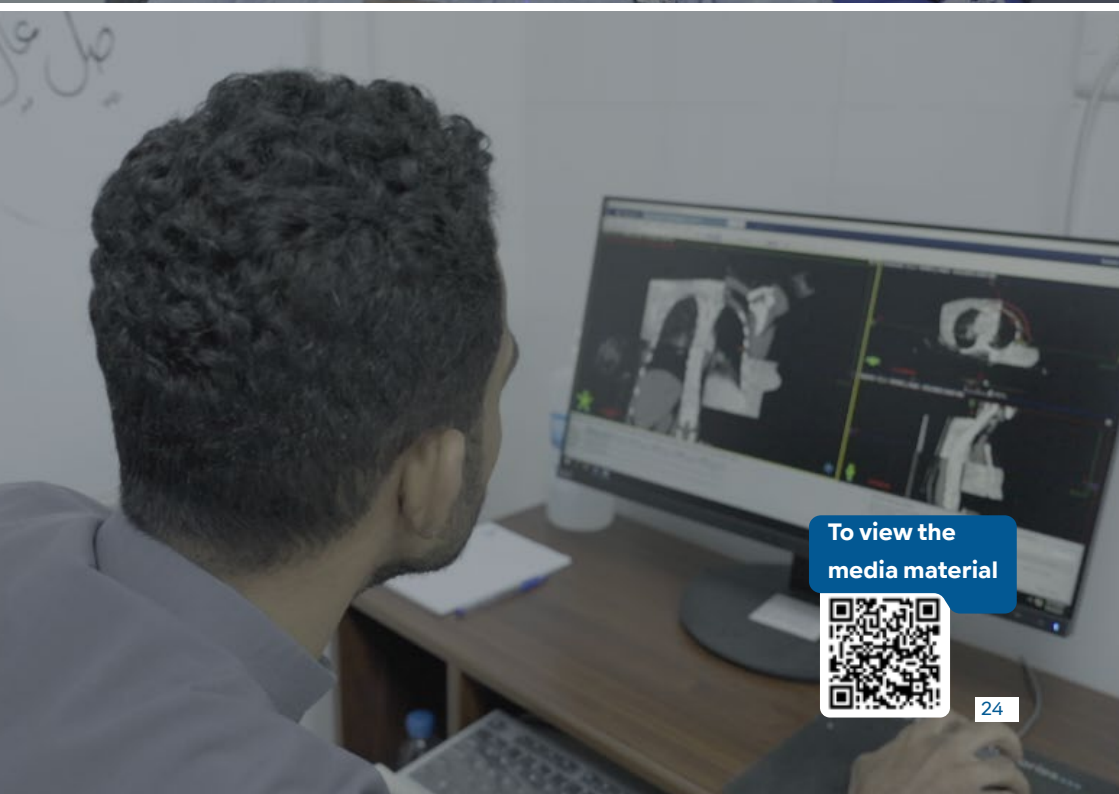

Breast Cancer Early Detection Campaign

Leading the awareness effort, the 2025 Breast Cancer Early Detection Campaign was launched under the slogan "You are the Foundation... Get Checked." Held under the auspices of the local authority and sponsored by Mr. Mabkhout Mubarak bin Madi, Governor of Hadhramaut, the campaign aimed to empower the community with systematic knowledge and clinical examinations. The activities resulted in widespread community engagement and an influx to early detection clinics, confirming the campaign's success in transforming awareness into action and stimulating demand for preventive services to increase survival rates.

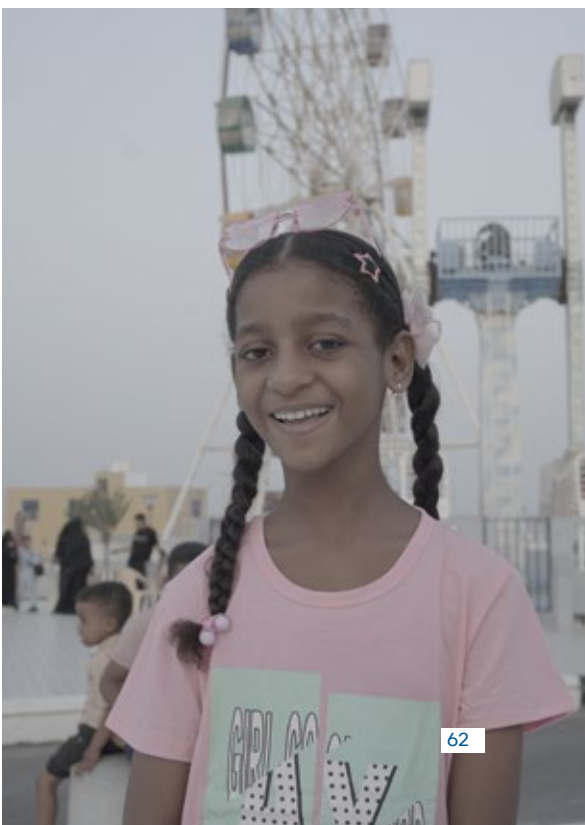
